If your patient has:

- Abdominal or chest pain
 - Difficulty swallowing (dysphagia)
 - Failure to thrive
 - Food that gets caught in the throat
 - Nausea
 - Gastro-esophageal reflux (that does not improve with anti-reflux medicine)
 - Unexplained weight loss
- ...your patient may have Eosinophilic Esophagitis (EoE)

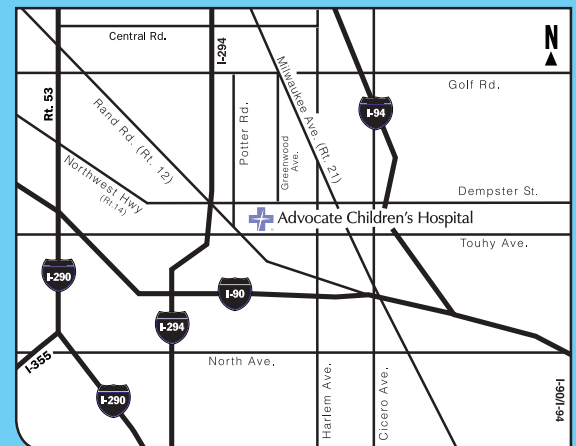
If you think your patient may have EoE, a referral to the Esophageal Center means your patient will receive:

- Expert care by a board certified pediatric gastroenterologist, pediatric allergist, registered dietitian, and clinical psychologist
- An individualized treatment plan
- Coordinated diagnostic services and treatment from a multidisciplinary team with the help of one point person: the Nurse Navigator.

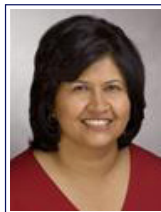

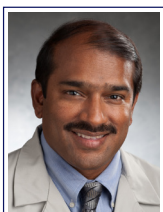
